SUBJECT: Supplemental Tactics, Techniques and Procedures (TTP) for the 2003 Defender Challenge Competition

1. The 2003 Defender Challenge Competition will be a world-class competition as well as a useful force development exercise. This year, each MAJCOM and Allied team will compete organized as a 10-person Transformation Squad. Throughout the competition the Air Force Force Protection Battlelab (AFFPB) will collect data on the performance of each squad. This data will help evaluate how, the 10-person squad equipped with new technology and operating with revised TTPs, compares to the present 13-person squad configuration.
2. In accordance with 2003 Defender Challenge Rules Brochure, the following TTPs are provided to assist teams in training for the competition. The attached TTPs are not intended to be all encompassing but supplemental to existing Air Force policy and guidance. The TTPs cover the basic organization, tactical formations and planning considerations for a 10-person Transformation Squad. Additionally, these tasks generally cover the spectrum of tasks that may be performed during the 2003 Defender Challenge Competition. Each MAJCOM and Allied team is highly encouraged to take these TTPs and develop internal standard operating procedures (SOPs).
