

The United States Air Force started issuing Law Enforcement Officer Safety Act (LEOSA) Credentials on 1 Nov 14, to actively serving or retired/separated Air Police, Security Police and Security Forces members. Below is an example of the credential. The credential is equipped with 10 anti-counterfeiting and security features:

1. Irregular background with line width modulation (printing in rainbow)
2. Micro-text
3. Micro-text (printing in rainbow)
4. Guilloche
5. Raster effect
6. OVI (magenta/green)
7. Irregular background with line width modulation (double background)
8. Anti-scan
9. Background with line width modulation
10. Relief (printing in rainbow)

In order for the named individual to carry a concealed weapon, pursuant to 18 USC 920B, this credential must be accompanied by a current (within the most recent 12 months) firearms qualification certification from the US Air Force (Air Force Form 522). If the State has not established LEOSA firearms qualification standards, the instructor will certify the officer has completed the LEOSA Security Forces (original) qualification course conducted by a State certified police firearms instructor using the member's privately owned firearm and personally procured ammunition. The named individual shall not carry a firearm while under the influence of alcohol or another intoxicating or habit-forming drug or substance, and shall not be permitted by Federal law from receiving a firearm.

This credential does not grant the bearer any authority to act on the agency's behalf or to exercise any law enforcement authority.
